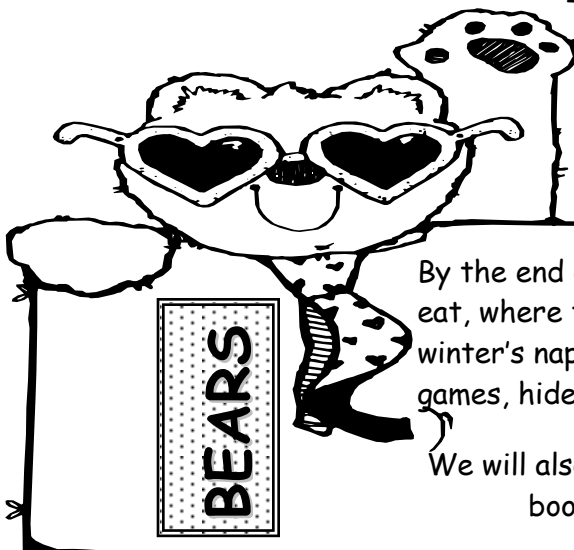


THE EAGLES NEST --(NOVEMBER 2011)

Time: **Morning class** arrive at Galaxy Bowl --- 10:15

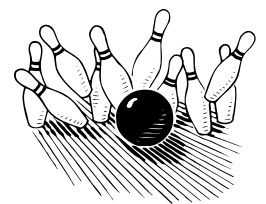
