



♥ A Typical Day at Preschool

MEI Preschool offers a Christian-based program. The children begin their day with "Welcome Time." At "Welcome Time" they learn about what they will do that day, find out who has a "helper" job, look at the monthly calendar and weekly weather charts, sing songs, and hear stories. We learn so much and have fun together at "Welcome Time."
